Light Dinner Options near Channing Daughter's
Suggestions from AI

Best inexpensive/simple options

- American Pie Pizzeria - Bridgehampton — my pick. Pizza, slices, sandwiches; casual counter-service and close to the winery. Great if you just want something easy after wine tasting.
- The Pizza Place — another very casual option on Montauk Highway, with pizza and simple hot food. Around \$10–20.
- L&W Market — sandwiches, prepared foods and simple bowls. More of a market/café than a dinner restaurant, but good if you want something light. Note: it closes around 7pm, so it depends on your timing.
- Panera Bread — not exciting, but probably the easiest inexpensive option for soup/salad/sandwiches, and it stays open until 8pm.

I'd choose American Pie if you want pizza + beer/wine, casual atmosphere, no fuss, and not Hamptons-expensive.
